



Whitetail Lake Boat Ramp & Lake Access Rules

The WTL Board of Directors has placed a high priority on the following:

- Maintaining water quality
- Protecting our lake from the threat of invasive species
- Improving boating safety and education
- Preventing non-resident and non-approved vendor watercraft on our lake

Lake access rules

- All lake resident motorized and non-motorized watercraft will require a current Whitetail Lake sticker and lot number. You will need to fill out the **Whitetail Lake Boat and ATV Registration Form** identifying your watercraft, and you will need to sign off that you clearly understand and agree to each of the following:
 1. Agree to follow the Nebraska State boating regulations and the Whitetail Lake boating rules found in the Fifth Restated Rules and Regulations.
 2. Understand and comply with the **Whitetail Lake Invasive Species Protocol**.
 3. Agree not to put non-resident and non-vendor approved watercraft or other equipment (skis, wake boards, water toys etc.) on our lake.
 4. Agree to maintain proper liability insurance on all of your watercraft vessels on our lake.
 5. Homeowners/residents signing this form accept responsibility for your residence, family members and guests and the vendors you contract with.
 6. Agree not to transplant any vegetation from any other body of water into Whitetail Lake.



To obtain stickers for your watercraft and ATVs.

Complete the **Whitetail Lake Boat and ATV Registration Form** listing all vessels and ATVs. Vessels include motorized and non-motorized boats (ski boats, canoes, kayaks, paddle boards, paddle boats, fishing boats, jet skis, pontoon boats, etc.)

The registration form can be found on our website (www.whitetaillake.com). Just click on the Lake Access Rules & Forms tab.

For boats (as listed above) the stickers and lot numbers must be placed between the middle and the rear of the boat on the starboard side (drivers side). For paddle boards and ATVs place the sticker in an easily seen location.

To access the boat ramp gate.

In order to meet the objectives stated at the top of page 1, a locked gate has been installed on the boat ramp. You must pass the inspection criteria listed on the **Whitetail Lake Boat Ramp Gate Inspection Form**. A list of members with keys to the gate can be found on our website (www.whitetaillake.com) under the Contact tab. **Please try to plan and call ahead to avoid delays.**
